

Dear Fellow Baconators,

You couldn't attend the Bacon meeting? Shame on you! But no worries. We have a modest recap for you.

Melanie reported the latest election results. Not looking good for those we supported.

Nancy Abruzzo purchased retirement cards for Nancy Pelosi. All of them. From every store.

Melanie described the KRON "glitch" that caused her to race to the Civic Center to confront Lynda Roberts, the Marin County Registrar of Voters. Before the polls closed KRON aired an election update showing Andy Podshadley 100 votes short with 80% of precincts reporting. All other "results" were zero across the board. When confronted Lynda's face turned white. She had no answers. Melanie called KRON who said it was a "glitch." Not good enough. Where in the system was the "glitch?" Where did they get those numbers? Who input them? They don't just appear!

Pledge and Prayer (lead by Melanie).

Melanie stated that Tief ran a phenomenal campaign. Tief said she was disappointed and surprised. She thanked all her supporters. Then she described how she "came out of her shell" because of COVID. She began questioning narratives. She became willing to demand answers and offend some. She found her transition resulted in clarity of who is a good friend and who isn't. She met a LOT of people and is now like Heather in that wherever she goes she sees someone she knows.

She's OK with her loss and appreciates all the wonderful texts and emails she received. She also noted that even though they're still counting it is unlikely she will overcome Abbey Picus.

Break for dinner somewhere at this point. Mel then thanked Tien and Kaikai for being such wonderful hosts for our group.

Mel noted that the Tief/Abbey race was the strangest she'd seen.

On the "red wave." Democrats succeeded with their "Save Democracy" and "Abortion" fearmongering. RINOs and Democrats are blaming Trump, yet of the candidates he supported, 173 won and only 9 lost. Polling was massively wrong. They overestimated shy Trump voters and underestimated shy Democrats. Todd noted that we see 60-40% (or close) in so many results in CA.

There was a healthy debate on whether it was time to dump Trump and go with DeSantis. Some argued it was time while others argued we need both. Trump excels at exposing corruption and RINOs whereas DeSantis is far more articulate.

Ron Elijah then gave an update on election integrity. As for election results, he mentioned that he ran track in high school. Sometimes he thought he'd win a race, only to get lapped. But our favorite candidates had a similar experience while enduring insults and vicious attacks.

Ron estimated that more than 130K votes were cast. We'll get updated results at 5 pm on November 10<sup>th</sup> and every 2 days thereafter. The ROV has been tabulating ballots, but hasn't posted results later than 11 pm on November 8<sup>th</sup>.

Ron looks at it as two elections – one through 8 pm Election Day, then another afterwards.

When the ROV reports "precincts received" they mean all ballots have been sent to the Civic Center. They are still counting those ballots. Our candidates can expect the gap to close in their elections as more results come in.

He still needs volunteers to hang out at the Elections Department and learn their game.

Ron went on to describe that the Election Integrity Committee does not have the support of the Marin GOP, the CA GOP or the RNC. In fact, they work hard to suppress our findings.

He remains disturbed with the fact that elections staff go to the Post Office to pick up voted VBM envelopes. This is a clear breakdown of chain of custody requirements, especially if only one staff member goes.

Nancy Abruzzo commented that people want to know the things Ron has found. Ron then described his analysis of Marin voters 98 years old in 2020. There were 44 in 2020 and 35 of them voted. In 2008, when they were 86, only 26 of them voted; in 2012 on 20 voted; in 2016 none of them voted and in 2018 on 1 voted. He went on to describe other oddities with these voters.

Ron's findings are presented in a publication started by the EI Committee to go around the obstructionist Executive Committee of the Marin GOP. "neo Publius" Essay No. 8a is about the elderly vote in Marin County. Tief agreed to share that publication with all MMF members via email attachment.

Mel went on to note how biased the press was against Tief. Although she ran an open and transparent campaign, she was accused of running a secret "stealth" campaign. She then invited Chris to talk about his campaign.

Looking back, Chris would have done things differently. He was his own treasurer and campaign manager, two things he'd never done before. He decided against aggressively appealing for donations and kept his campaign expenses below \$5K. He wondered if Pat Eklund sending two full color fliers late in the campaign was because she was worried.

He decided early on that he wouldn't pander for votes and never did. He didn't want walkers of his neighborhoods hurt like the 86-y-o woman in Michigan campaigning against abortion that was shot in the back. He decided to tape palm cards on doors and talk only to those he

happened to meet. He estimated that 7 in 10 people he talked to support him or already voted for him. He doesn't believe the results he's seeing from the Marin Elections Department.

Chris went on to describe the opposition he received as EI Committee Chair from the Marin GOP, the CA GOP and the RNC. The RNC temporarily kicked him off their EI Committee for examining past elections for fraud to better monitor future elections. A thorough purge of RINOs is essential! Todd agreed vociferously, mentioning McConnell, McCarthy and Romney.

Mel mentioned a rumor that Rona McDaniel will be replaced by the Chair of the CA GOP (Jessica?). Chris thinks she's a patriot getting set up to take a fall by the CA GOP; Mel says "no," she's a RINO from her personal experience.

Mel shared a note from Terry (with a last name difficult to pronounce) commenting on "short-sighted" Marin voters.

Jessica F. pointed out that Lanhee Chen was supported by major newspapers in CA, yet still lost.

Mel said it's time again to become disrupters, become target, become the resistance. For example, we have to address a homeless problem that is becoming worse by the day.

Jeneane(sp?) from SF said all our messaging problems come down to the media. They're now blaming Trump for the "red wave" fizzle. Even good people within the media are being stifled. We need to find a way to go around the media and directly to the people.

We don't have media behind us and Mel doesn't know how to change that. Their agenda is devious and only gimmicks will get their attention. She used her Nancy Pelosi "hair dryer" protest as an example, which made international news within hours.

Now for the "Fun with Nancy Abruzzo" segment. She went to all the stores in town to purchase retirement cards for Speaker Nancy Pelosi. She passed them out and asked people to leave a clever message (nothing rude or threatening), stamp the envelope and drop in the mail.

Janine Pera gave an update on her escapades with Dr. Matt Willis, the Marin County Health Department and the Marin Board of Supervisors. Through her persistence she obtained much data to examine and clarify. They agree to meet with her.

Some data for the period 7/1/2021 through 9/17/2022: 70% of deaths in Marin County were those that were fully vaxxed. Of the 3000+ counties in the USA, Marin ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in percent of the population that is vaxxed.

Willis is now pivoting to the fentanyl crisis, which he tried to attribute to the pandemic. Janine then gave a litany of horrors caused by the County's response to COVID – unnecessary lockdowns, lost businesses, adverse vax reactions, the adverse impact of isolation on children, the increase in suicides, the job losses over vax mandates.

A deep dive into the numbers provided by the County suggests that 82% of the deaths in Marin County are among the fully vaxxed. Despite that the County is still pushing the ineffective vax!

Janine will now start looking at numbers from Sonoma County. She considers herself an educator on the issue.

Janine shared her findings from the Marin County Coroner. He's seeing a 20-25% increase in caseloads. Sudden Adult Death Syndrome?

Janine and others discussed pending mandates and how groups are now ready to sue to prevent them. Janine noted that CA is one of four states that are effectively without exemptions for the vax mandates.
