

# Resolution of the Marin Election Integrity Committee

Resolution #1

Special Meeting

Approved on April 18, 2023

## RESOLVE TO SUPPORT PRECINCT LEVEL SINGLE DAY ELECTIONS WITH PHOTO ID TO VOTE ON PAPER BALLOTS TABULATED AT THE PRECINCT LEVEL THEN REPORTED TO THE COUNTY

WHEREAS after several elections using mass Vote-By-Mail ballots that have failed nationally, statewide and in Marin County causing much voter frustration and disenfranchisement and cannot be ignored any longer; and

WHEREAS the Voter's Choice Act was not subjected to approval by California voters but implemented by the State of California and adopted by the Marin County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS the full negative effects of voter disenfranchisement caused by mass Vote-By-Mail and the Voter's Choice Act is immeasurable; and

WHEREAS inventory controls of mass Vote-By-Mail ballots is inadequate; and

WHEREAS the mass Vote-By-Mail and Voter's Choice Act election system is susceptible to ballot fraud and election fraud; and

WHEREAS implementation of the Voter's Choice Act is far more time-consuming, costly, and less reliable than single day voting at the precinct level; and

WHEREAS the Voter's Choice Act election system shifts the maintenance of voter rolls from the counties to the state; and

WHEREAS the Voter's Choice Act election system shifts the tabulation of votes from several people in several precincts to a single person in a centralized location at the Civic Center; and

WHEREAS the mass Vote-By-Mail ballot election system with voter rolls maintained by the state is subject to fraudulent and phantom ballots injected into our elections; and

WHEREAS the Voter's Choice Act election system provides inadequate means to verify the qualification of individuals registering to vote, now:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Marin Election Integrity Committee supports restoring precinct level single day voting with photo ID to vote on paper ballots tabulated at the precinct level and reported to the county.
